This meeting is organised by the Scottish Motor Racing Club governed by the General Competition Rules of Motorsport UK, incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA, additional Supplementary Regulations as well as Motorsport UK COVID-19 Guidelines for events and any written instructions the organisers issue for the event including the Knockhill COVID-19 Operations Protocol (Issue 2). Passes: There will be no passes issued for this event. All attendees must be pre-nominated and names will be checked at the entrance. Access will not be permitted to anyone who has not been pre-nominated.

Venue Access: Access to the Paddock Area for competitors not testing will be via the Paddock Entrance from 11:30 Saturday 12th September. Competitors taking part in testing may access the circuit from 07:30. Testing must be booked with Knockhill Racing Circuit via their website <https://www.knockhill.com/testing/car-testing>. It is possible to set-up on Friday 11th September before 18:00 when the gate will be closed and locked, re-opening at 07:30 on Saturday.

Paddock: Please park neatly in the space allocated to your championship / series without wasting space. Private cars and non-essential vehicles should be parked in Paddock 5 (gravel area on the left immediately after entering the Paddock entrance) and not in the main Paddock area. All vehicles and team equipment is left at the owners risk and neither the organisers nor circuit operators can be held liable for any loss or damage, howsoever caused.

Signing On for Competitors: All competitors must complete the self-declaration in advance of the event.

Scrutineering: All competitors must complete the self-declaration in advance of the event.

Drivers Briefings: All drivers must watch the supplied video briefing and read the accompanying briefing notes. All drivers who have not raced at Knockhill before must attend the 'Zoom' video conference briefing to be scheduled for 12.00 noon on Saturday 12th September.

Timings: All timings will take place in accordance with the published timetable.

Final Instructions

Circuit Access: Access to the Circuit for all sessions will be via the Assembly Area. All cars may be noise tested in compliance with Motorsport UK General Regulation J.5.17-18 prior to being released onto the circuit. Drivers should go to the Assembly Area 15 minutes before published times and then when directed by the marshals they should proceed onto the circuit.

Stop/Go & Drive Through Penalties: The Clerk of the Course reserves the right to impose a 'Stop/Go Penalty / Drive Through penalty' in accordance with Motorsport UK Regulation [Q 12.6].

End of Track Session Procedure: At the end of each track session, all vehicles must slow down and enter the Pitlane following the marshals instructions to return to the Paddock / Parc-Ferme area as required.

Official Notice Board / Information: The organisers will try to run the programme as published, but they reserve the right to delay or bring forward event times to suit the conditions of the day. Copies of practice times & results will be published online at www.smart-timing.co.uk

Entry List: Please check your entry on the published entry list and notify us immediately if it is incorrect, this will ensure an accurate programme.

Protests / Appeals:

Protests and Appeals should be lodged in accordance with Motorsport UK General Regulations electronically via info@smrc.co.uk. All judicial procedures undertaken will be done electronically. Penalties will announced verbally and published electronically on the Official Notice Board.

Awards Presentation: Presentations will be made after each session respecting physical distancing and the Knockhill COVID-19 Operations Protocol.

COVID-19 precautions: Please read and familiarise yourself with the Knockhill COVID-19 Operations Protocol document (Issue 2) prior to attending. Face coverings must be worn by all personnel at all times whilst at the circuit, except when wearing your crash helmet in the car. Physical distancing of minimum 2 metres must be maintained wherever possible and you must remain within your 'Competitor Bubble' at all times, restricted to the driver and their nominated essential team personnel only. Multi-car teams must consist of a maximum of 15 personnel from a maximum of 5 households.
