This meeting is organised by the Scottish Motor Racing Club governed by the General Competition Rules of Motorsport UK, incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA, additional Supplementary Regulations as well as Motorsport UK COVID-19 Guidelines for events and any written instructions the organisers issue for the event including the Knockhill COVID-19 Operations Protocol (Issue 3). These Final Instructions should be read in conjunction with any further instructions or bulletins issued by the organisers.

Passes: There will be no passes issued for this event. All attendees must be pre-nominated and names will be checked at the entrance. Access will not be permitted to anyone who has not been pre-nominated.

Venue Access: Access will be via the Paddock Entrance. Competitors wishing to arrive on Saturday 17th July may access Paddock 1 during the day and Paddock 2 from 5pm. Raceday access will be from 7am on Sunday 18th July. On Sunday 18th July only personnel nominated during the pre-event sign-on process will be admitted.

Paddock: Please park neatly in the space allocated to your championship / series without wasting space. Private cars and non-essential vehicles should be parked in Paddock 5 (gravel area on the left immediately after entering the Paddock entrance) and not in the main Paddock area. All vehicles and team equipment is left at the owners risk and neither the organisers nor circuit operators can be held liable for any loss or damage, howsoever caused.

Signing On for Competitors: All competitors must complete the self-declaration in advance of the event.

Scrutineering: All competitors must complete the self-declaration in advance of the event.

Drivers Briefings: All drivers must read the Drivers' briefing notes in advance of the event.

There will be a Drivers' Briefing for **Scottish Ford Fiesta ST** competitors at 11:30 in the Pitlane Garages. Attendance is mandatory and please ensure that face coverings are worn and 2m physical distancing is respected when attending the briefing.

Timings: All timings will take place in accordance with the published timetable.

Final Instructions

Circuit Access: Access to the Circuit for all sessions will be via the Assembly Area. All cars may be noise tested in compliance with Motorsport UK General Regulation J.5.17-18 prior to being released onto the circuit. Drivers should go to the Assembly Area 15 minutes before published times and then when directed by the marshals they should proceed onto the circuit.

Stop/Go & Drive Through Penalties: The Clerk of the Course reserves the right to impose a 'Stop/Go Penalty / Drive Through penalty' in accordance with Motorsport UK Regulation [Q 12.26].

End of Track Session Procedure: At the end of each track session, all vehicles must slow down and enter the Pitlane following the marshals instructions to return to the Paddock / Parc-Fermé area as required.

Official Notice Board / Information: The organisers will try to run the programme as published, but they reserve the right to delay or bring forward event times to suit the conditions of the day.

Protests / Appeals:

Protests and Appeals should be lodged in accordance with Motorsport UK General Regulations electronically via info@smrc.co.uk. All judicial procedures undertaken will be done electronically. Penalties will announced verbally and published electronically on the Official Notice Board.

Awards Presentation: Presentations will be made after each session respecting physical distancing and the Knockhill COVID-19 Operations Protocol.

Marshals Instructions: All marshals and officials must be pre-approved and complete the self-declaration in advance of the event. Access to the track will be from 11:30am and all marshals should be in position by 11:45am ready for a track inspection at 11:50am.

COVID-19 precautions: Please read and familiarise yourself with the Knockhill COVID-19 Operations Protocol document (Issue 3) prior to attending. Face coverings must be worn by all personnel whilst in the Pitlane, Assembly Area, Parc-Ferme, inside all buildings and enclosed spaces and in the Paddock when unable to maintain 2m physical distancing, except when wearing your crash helmet in the car. Physical distancing of minimum 2 metres must be maintained wherever possible and you must remain within your 'Competitor Bubble' at all times, restricted to the driver and their nominated team personnel only.
