Passes: All personnel will require an e-ticket to access the venue.

Venue Access: Access to the venue and paddock areas will be from 18:00 Friday 10th September 2021.

Paddock: Please park neatly in the space allocated to your championship / series without wasting space. All vehicles and team equipment is left at the owners risk and neither the organisers nor circuit operators can be held liable for any loss or damage, howsoever caused. **No race engines must be run before 08:30 or after 18:45.** The Paddock must be vacated by 21:00 on Sunday 12th September. Any competitor wishing to stay on site until Monday morning must vacate the main paddock area.

Signing On for Competitors: All competitors must complete the self-declaration in advance of the event.

Scrutineering: All competitors must complete the self-declaration in advance of the event.

Drivers Briefings: All drivers must read the Drivers' briefing notes in advance of the event.

Timings: All timings will take place in accordance with the published timetable.

Track Access: Access to the Track will be via the Assembly Area. All cars may be noise tested in compliance with Motorsport UK General Regulation J.5.17-18 prior to being released onto the track. Drivers should be ready 15 minutes before published times and then when directed by the marshals they should proceed onto the track.

Stop/Go & Drive Through Penalties: The Clerk of the Course reserves the right to impose a 'Stop/Go Penalty / Drive Through penalty' in accordance with Motorsport UK Regulation [Q 12.26].

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End of Track Session Procedure: At the end of each track session, all vehicles must slow down and exit the track via the slip road on the left hand side at Mountain Bottom following the marshals instructions to return to the Paddock / Parc-Fermé as required.

Race Starts / Grids: Prior to each race, cars will be released from the Assembly Area to proceed directly to the grid and form up in the positions specified on the published grid sheet. The countdown will then commence at the 1 minute signal followed by a formation lap before a standing start in accordance with the relevant Championship / Series regulations.

Allcomers Race: The SMRC will organise an Allcomers Race, consisting of a 20 minute practice session and 15 lap race. The race is open to drivers entered into one of the Scottish Championship races scheduled for the event. The entry fee is £100. Starting positions will be determined by practice times in accordance with Motorsport UK General Regulation Q.12.4. Additionally each competitor will be allocated a target time for the race based on average lap times relative to the class entered, using times set during both the Allcomers Qualifying session and the relevant Scottish Championship Qualifying session. There will be two separate race results issued, an overall race result and a result determined against the target time.

Official Notice Board / Information: The organisers will try to run the programme as published, but they reserve the right to delay or bring forward event times to suit the conditions of the day.

Penalties will announced verbally and published electronically on the Official Digital Notice Board.

Awards Presentation: Presentations will be made after each race at the Paddock Office / Podium.

Marshals / Officials Instructions: Marshals and Officials should sign-on online ahead of the event. Track marshals should be on post for 08:40 ready for a Track Inspection at 08:50.
