The Stewards have received a petition from Performance Tek Racing, Entrant of Car #12 in the Scottish Mini Cooper Cup, for them to review, in accordance with Chapter 2, Appendix 10 of the National Competition Rules, the following decision made by them at the Competition:

Stewards Decision relating to the incident in Mini Race 1 between Car #27 and Car #12

The Stewards, having examined additional video evidence, summoned and heard the Entrants representative, determine the following:

Decision: there is a <u>significant and relevant</u> <u>new</u> element which was <u>unavailable</u> to the parties seeking the review at the time of the decision concerned.

Reason: In car video footage from Car 88, which was immediately behind Car 12 prior to the intervention of Car 27, was not previously available when the original review and decision was taken. This newly available video footage clearly shows the events leading to the heavy contact incident between Cars 27 and car 12. This video evidence, previously unavailable to the parties seeking review, does in the Stewards decision, justify the review requested. The review petition is therefore upheld and the fee is not due.

Competitors are reminded that, in accordance with Chapter 2, Appendix 10, Article 13 of the National Competition Rules, this decision is not subject to appeal.
