Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK NCR(s)

Ch.12 App.7 Art.1.8 - Causing a collision

## **Brief Details:**

A report was received of front-to-rear contact between Cars 88 (Scott Charles) and 44 (Peter Edie) at McIntyres (Post 3), resulting in Car 44 spinning, and Car 88 running wide into the gravel.

Following investigation by Assistant Clerk of the Course, Mark Leybourne, it was established that Car 88 had not established sufficient overlap, making contact with the right-rear of Car 44 at the apex, and was therefore wholly responsible for causing a collision.

Therefore it is decided to penalise Car 88 with with addition of 30 seconds to their race time, in accordance with guideline penalties outlined in Scottish Hot Hatch Championship Sporting Regulation SR 4.3 Table of Penalties. This carries with it 3 penalty points on the the driver of Car 88's competition licence.

Addition of 30 seconds to your race time
