Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK NCR(s)

Ch.12 App.7 Art.1.8 - Causing a collision

Brief Details:

A report was received of contact on the last lap at Taylor's Hairpin (Post 9, Turn 9) between Car 1 (Ayden Wilson) and Car 8 (Henry Gillespie).

Upon investigation by Assistant Clerk of the Course, Richard Crozier, it was found that Car 1 had made a move up the inside of Car 8 from far back on the brakes, making side to side contact with Car 8 at the apex. However, on the exit of the corner, Car 1 made visible efforts - inc. short-shifting - to hand back the place on the run to the control/finish line and rectify any advantage gained. Nonetheless, the driver of Car 1 is found to have been wholly responsible for causing a collision.

On this occasion, given the noted efforts to cede any advantage gained, it is decided to deviate from the standard addition of 30 seconds to their race time as per the guideline penalties outlined in Scottish Hot Hatch Championship Sporting Regulation SR 4.3 Table of Penalties, and instead issue a Written Reprimand to the driver of Car 1. This carries with it 2 penalty points on the the driver of Car 27's competition licence.

Discussion with drivers of Cars 1 and 8
