Both Drivers interviewed and while watching the video of 44 commentated that they were racing very close with several overtakes on each other, at the hairpin car 44 took the inside line, just getting past car 6 both running wide with understeer, at this point contact was made. No change of position or advantage gained.
With this in mind it is deemed a racing incident with no further action
