Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK NCR(s)

Ch.2 Ann A Art.1.3 - Obtaining an unfair advantage

Brief Details:

A report was received of a 3-wide incident between Cars 52 (Michael Williams), Car 27 (Martin Wijetunga) and 17 (Chris Cockburn) at Duffus/Leslies (Post 1+). Following investigation by Assistant Clerk of the Course, Richard Crozier, it was found that Car 17 was behind Car 27 on the exit of Turn 1 Duffus, before shortcutting across the concrete on the inside of Turn 2 Leslie, emerging out in front of both Cars 27 and 52 upon rejoining, before taking a defensive line into Turn 3 McIntyres. Having examined the available evidence and representations from both drivers, the driver of Car 17 was found to have gained an unfair advantage by leaving the defined racing circuit - in accordance with NCR 2.A.1.3.a., the clerks decide upon a time penalty of 5 seconds to be applied to Car 17's race time. This does not carry with it any penalty points on the driver's competition licence.

Evidence Relied Upon:

Representations from driver of Car 52 Michael Williams and driver of Car 17 Chris Cockburn, onboard footage from both cars (front facing), plus external crowd footage from outside of McIntyres.

Accordingly, under NCR Ch.5A App.5 Art.2, I hereby order that you receive the following:

Addition of 5 seconds to your race time

You are reminded of your right of appeal.

Any penalties applied will be reported to the Stewards of the Event for forwarding to Motorsport UK in accordance with NCR Ch.5A App.5 Art.2.4
