Brief Details:

A report was received of Car 52 (Michael Williams) running wide on the exit of McIntyres (Post 3). Following investigation by Assistant Clerk of the Course, Richard Crozier, it was found that there was slight contact between Car 52 on the extreme inside and Car 27 (Martin Wijetunga) slightly further left, on the entry to the corner, resulting in Car 52 proceeding onto the grass on the inside on corner entry, overshooting, and running wide into the gravel on corner exit. Having examined the available evidence and representations from the drivers of Cars 52 and 27, and the entrant of 52 (Malcolm McNab), it was found that owing to combination of Car 27 moving under braking / crowding of a vehicle beyond the edge of the track, and Car 52 failing to achieve sufficient overlap, on balance of probability no single party could be found to be solely to blame, and therefore it was decided to take No Further Action.

Evidence Relied Upon:

Representations from driver of Car 52 (Michael) Williams plus their entrant (Malcolm McNab), driver of Car 27 (Martin Wijetunga), circuit CCTV footage, and onboard footage from Car both cars (front facing).
