Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK NCR(s)

Ch.12 App.7 Art.1.8 - Causing a collision

Brief Details:

A report was received of Car 47 (Presley Barrett) running wide through gravel at Chicane (Post 4), followed by contact between Cars 47 and 17 (Chris Cockburn) at Clarks (Post 6), resulting in Car 17 running wide through the gravel. Following investigation by Assistant Clerk of the Course, Richard Crozier, it was found that, Car 17 having pulled alongside / ahead on the inside prior to turn-in point for Clarks, the front-right corner of Car 47 had made contact with the left-rear of Car 17 at the turn-in point, pivoting Car 17 into the gravel. Having examined the available evidence and representations from both drivers, the driver of Car 47 was found to have turned in / gotten loose upon entry downshift with Car 17 alongside, and is therefore predominantly responsible for causing a collision - in accordance with 2026 Scottish Hot Hatch Championship Sporting Regulations Art 4.3 Table of Penalties, the clerks apply the addition of a (decreased) 5 seconds added to Car 47's race time, and 3 penalty points added to the driver's competition licence.

Evidence Relied Upon:

Representations from driver of Car 17 (Chris Cockburn) and driver of Car 47 (Presley Barrett), circuit CCTV footage, and onboard footage from both cars (front facing).

Accordingly, under NCR Ch.5A App.5 Art.2, I hereby order that you receive the following:

Addition of 5 seconds to your race time
Number of Licence Penalty Points: **3**

You are reminded of your right of appeal.
