Report of contact between 17 and 47 resulting in 17 in the barriers and 47 off track.
Live stream video and in car videos reviewed.
Both drivers interviewed.
Car 47 was accompanied by his entrant.
Our decision is car 17 was predominantly responsible for the collision.
As this was the final race of the day and the driver did not finish, he is penalised with a three place grid penalty at his next round and 3 penalty points added to his license.
